In so doing we have been able to comply with many of your request as to site location, available area attractions, and convenience of planned activities without the need for extended travel away from our hotel. Colorado Springs is in the heart of 26 Pikes Peak county attractions which will offer all Reunion attendees the ultimate in Colorado vacationing.

Purpose: This is a great opportunity for long time friends and career associates to enjoy the fun and fellowship of seeing each other again, while experiencing the vast array of amenities offered by our selected property.

Nestled in the shadows of Colorado's Rocky Mountains the Cheyenne Mountain Resort (**CMR**) is a premier four season resort. Its 316 guest rooms and suites are arranged in eight residential lodges surrounding the main building, lobby, restaurants, and conference rooms. Its amenities include an 18- hole championship Pete Dye – designed golf course; five swimming pools; tennis and racquetball courts; fitness center; aquatics center; and a 35 acre recreation lake. It is a AAA Four Diamond rated facility.

Room Rates: European Plan – Single Rate: \$160.00 Double Rate: \$175.00 Rates quoted are for a **double queen** room, per day **to include** breakfast in the Mountain View Restaurant, and Facilities Service Charge, and are subject to applicable state, local taxes. **Rate is available 3 days pre and post the contracted dates based on availability.**

The Facilities Service Charge, included in the quoted rate, provides wireless internet access in guestrooms and public areas, 800 and local call access, newspaper, in-room coffee and tea, fitness center access, and free parking.

Room Upgrade: CMR charges a \$25/per night fee to “confirm” or “guarantee” a King Bed Room upon arrival. **We have negotiated for 10 King Bed rooms out of our 25 room block to be available without the \$25 upgrade fee. After these 10 King Bed rooms have been reserved,** all additional King Bed rooms requested will be subject to the \$25/per night /per room Upgrade Fee. This will guarantee the availability of the King Bed room upon one's arrival. Should however, you wish to avoid the \$25 upgrade fee, you may reserve a double queen room now, and upon arrival request an upgrade to a King Bed Room. **Based on availability** at the time of your arrival, CMR will upgrade you **without any upgrade fee.**

Room Block: We have a room block of 25 rooms until July 1, 2014. At that time we will be able to adjust the room down by 20% if needed. Any upward adjustment will be made at that time based on rooms reserved which exceed the 25 room block count.

Cut-Off Dates: The above room blocks are guaranteed until 5:00 PM, July 25, 2014. Upon this date and time all unused rooms in the block will be released for general sale. Reservation requests received after aforementioned cut-off date will be provided on a space and rate available basis.

Reservations: Individual reservations may be made by calling CMR at **(719-538-4000) or (800-428-8886).** Only those rooms reserved under the “TEXACO ALUMNI REUNION 2014” room block will be available at the above quoted room rates. **Therefore when calling for your reservation specifically state that you want to make a reservation for the “Texaco Alumni Reunion 2014.** Individual room reservations will be guaranteed and held with a personal credit card, however no charges will be made to the card at that time. We have negotiated a cancelation policy of 48 hours prior to your scheduled arrival. Room cancelations made inside the 48 hour time line will be accountable for the 1st night room charge.

Your planning committee encourages everyone who plans on attending to make their CMR reservations as soon as possible. It is important that we

have a good estimate of attendees as we continue to select dining and hospitality room space. We hope each of you will take advantage of the extended room rate for 3 days pre and post of August 25-28. **It is especially important for those wanting to reserve rooms August 28 and after, to do so soon.** That is Labor Day weekend and is in the height of CMR's season. Pre and post rooms will be on a space available basis, so you do not want to wait too long.

Golf: Golf is planned for Tuesday and Wednesday, August 26 & 27. Don Holden and Don Cook will work with CMR golf pro, Matt Cohen, to set up a skins game with full handicaps on Tuesday, and our traditional Texaco Tournament on Wednesday. All golfers will enjoy the Pete-Dye championship course built around the 35 acre lake and the beauty of the Colorado Rocky Mountains surrounding the entire 18 holes. We have negotiated a \$90 green fee which includes 18 holes of golf, range balls and ½ cart. This is a 40% reduction in the normal guest fee of \$150.



Airport: Colorado Springs has an airport to which you can schedule flights, however you will have a wider choice of airlines, including Southwest Air, using the Denver CO. Airport. It is an easy hour and 15 minute drive south from Denver to CMR. Should you fly into Colorado Spring's A/P there is an \$18.00 per person one way or \$30.00 per person round trip transportation service from the Airport available. Arrivals need to be scheduled by prior reservation. Departures from CMR scheduled on the hour, every hour, starting at 5:00am.

What's Included: Your upfront \$115 per person registration fee covers: All Admin. Expenses, three breakfasts (included in room rate), and two evening group plated dinners to be served in a banquet setting. In addition we will have a selected room for our hospitality hour (4:00pm – 6:30pm) with a cash bar available in the room. **As a separate attachment to this announcement you have our “Texaco Alumni Reunion 2014” Registration form.
